Experiential Learning

- Participate in four weeks of **interactive training sessions**.
- Identify a **mentor** to guide your development.
- Complete a sixteen-week **developmental assignment** outside of your position of record.
- Conduct **interviews** with members of the Senior Executive Service to gain perspective and expand your network.
- Shadow senior executives to observe **leadership in action**.
- Work with an inter-agency **Action Learning Team** to provide recommendations for performance improvement to a sponsoring agency.
